## Attendance and Lateness

The attendance of the majority of pupils at Corpusty Primary School is very good which is fantastic as this means that these pupils are not missing out on learning. The school starts promptly at 8:50am and pupils settle straight to work as soon as they arrive in class. 
## School Uniform
