

What's a typical day like at Corpusty Primary School?

8:35-8:50:	Arrive at school
8:50:	Bell rings – Line up
10:15:	Assembly*
10:30-10:50:	Breaktime
12:00:	Lunchtime
1:15:	Bell rings – Line up
3:30:	School finishes

*Friday: Superstar Assembly at 9:00 - family welcome.

Break time

- Reception children and those entitled to free school meals will have milk provided. Others can order milk online; contact the office for details.
- Reception and KS1 children will be provided with a fruit or veg snack.
- All children can bring in a fruit or veg snack for break and a water bottle (no squash or juice).

Lunch time

- All Reception and KS1 children are entitled to free school meals but can bring a pack up if they prefer.
- The office will send out a menu with the choices available.
- Let the office know by Monday registration time what you child would like for the week ahead.

What do I need to know about drop off and pick up?

- Please bring your child in the side gate opposite the school hall unless you arrive late.
- Children can be dropped off 8:35-8:50.
- Reception and Year 1 children can be taken into school and helped to hang up their belongings before returning to the playground.
- Any permission slips, correspondence can be put in the black post box opposite entrance.
- Any money should be delivered to the office.
- If your child is unable to attend please contact the school office by 9am.
- The side gate is locked at 8:50, if you arrive after this time please enter via the front gate and report to the office.
- At the end of the day, Reception and Year 1 and 2 will be released by the teacher through the blue wooden gate once they see the identified collector.
- A member of staff mans the side gate at drop off and pick up times.
- Please inform staff/office if a different person is collecting your child. Please provide a codeword to identify themselves with if they are not known to the school



What does my child need for school?

Winter School Uniform

- Emerald or navy sweatshirt/cardigan
- Emerald or navy poloshirt
- Navy skirt or trousers
- Plain dark tights or socks
- Shoes or boots should be black (Not trainers)

Summer School Uniform

- Emerald or navy sweatshirt/cardigan
- Emerald or navy poloshirt
- Navy skirt or trousers
- Or blue or jade check dress
- Shoes or boots should be black (Not trainers)
- Sunhat

PE kit

- Navy T-shirt
- Navy or black shorts or joggers
- Plimsoles or trainers
- A drawstring bag which will hang on coat peg
PE kit to remain in school during the week

Water bottle

Book bag

****All items should be clearly named****

What can I do to help my child be ready for School?

Help them to be able to:

- Recognise their name.
- Put on their coat themselves.
- Put on their shoes themselves – Velcro shoes are easiest.
- Change into their P.E. kit, including repacking their P.E. bag.
