Due to another lockdown we were unable to run any of the traditional fund raising events that involved parents, grandparents, friends and relatives, such as the mulled wine and mince pies at the Nativity in Corpusty & Saxthorpe church, Christmas Draw, Christmas craft fair, Sports day with BBQ, Family Fun day, cake & skates, pancake day as well as various cake sales for Mother's Day & May Day.

Luckily the 100 Club has continued to bring in a regular income to the Friends.

Without the Go Fund Me money and the Tesco Groundwork money our income would only have been £718.

Also we didn't receive a donation of £500 from the Bonfire committee as it was cancelled due to Covid-19.

Children also missed out on traditional Corpusty Friends fun events such as a whole school Johnny Jaffa cake Halloween disco with refreshments, a whole school Johnny Jaffa cake Christmas disco with refreshments, Easter Fair with cake raffle & tombola, Easter bingo and a whole school Christmas Party lunch with home-made cakes. The unprecedented year of Covid has been followed by another, with the added difficulties of the break in, another lockdown and a flood.</p> <p>It is thanks to Sophie and Jenni for their work acquiring money from Tesco blue tokens and Go Fund Me, that our funds have ended the year so healthily.</p> <p>We all feel sad that children and parents have not been able to be part of our usual events but Katharine explained that the Friends have had a very positive effect on the children in the school; the learning packs were useful and used educationally for online learning, the plants and windchimes etc turned round the children's return to school when the windows had not yet been replaced and Christmas gifts from Santa and party boxes really did give the children some excitement at Christmas.
