



CORNERSTONES CURRICULUM





- Subjects will include History, Geography, Science, Art, Design and Technology and RE.



OUR CURRICULUM



- At Corpusty and Foulsham, we already share a broad Curriculum, during our last Ofsted inspection our English, Maths, Science, History and Geography subject areas were recognized as strengths.
- In June 2022 the Ofsted inspection at Corpusty noted that in a small number of subjects the curriculum does not make it clear the most important things that pupils need to know.
- The introduction of Cornerstones Curriculum will strengthen those other subject areas through knowledge, vocabulary and the sequencing of lessons.




Freshly painted railings at Foulsham.

New doors and guttering work on their way at Corpusty.



RESIDENTIAL TRIPS

- As part of our Corpusty and Foulsham Passport we are looking forward to two upcoming residential trips:
- March 13-15th 2023 – Year 3 and 4 children to Eaton Vale Activity Centre near Norwich – 3 days and 2 nights.
- October 2023 - A 4 night residential to Castleton in the Peak District for year 5 and 6 children.



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THE COST OF LIVING

- No requirement for school uniform to have the school logo.
- A limited number of charity events across the year – where we choose to do these, there is no requirement for families to contribute, however all children can take part.
- Avoiding dress up/costume days which might put pressure on families to feel like they need to purchase a costume.
- Costs considered when planning trips to make them as affordable as we can.
- Payment plans available to help families.
- Greatly reduced cost of trips for 'Pupil Premium' funded children.
