This academic year we were able to run lots of events. The children have enjoyed so many new experiences this academic year. They all went on a whole school trip to the Pantomime at Sheringham Little Theatre to watch 'Cinderella' with coach travel and ice creams included. They also went on a whole school trip to Sheringham park National Trust.

They also benefitted from the regular annual events; Christmas presents from visiting Father Christmas and his Christmas Elf, a Christmas raffle, an Easter bingo, Easter garden and bonnet competition, an Easter egg hunt, Mayday festivities with a gorgeous Mayday school fence and arch, pancake races, a sponsored nature treasure hunt, numerous cake & skates as well as ice lolly sales and preloved book sale as well as a celebration end of year disco party. Also, the Corpusty village sausage sizzle tombola stall was an excellent opportunity for children to help run the fundraising stall in the summer holidays.

The Year 6 benefitted from personalised leavers hoodies, Oxford English dictionaries and Casio scientific calculators. So, a highly successful year. ☺

We purchased two large outdoor wall maps for £376; one of the world and one of the UK, £216 raised at Mike Linley's wildlife talk was put towards this purchase. The children have really enjoyed looking at the maps. We also purchased a selection of balls for all the children to use in the playground at break times.

The 100 club continues be a fantastic annual fundraiser (£655) as well as the Christmas raffle. (£340) This is a fantastic total of £995. Thank you, Pat, for your continued dedication and hard work.

We were lucky to be donated £306 from the Corpusty and Saxthorpe youth group that unfortunately does not run anymore, as well as £18 from East fundraising. We also sold a Zidane football shirt for £50 that was donated to the Friends by a parent.

After the hugely successful Break GoGo hares 'Dandelion hare' in 2018 and GoGo discover 'Pollenasaurus' dinosaur in 2022 we are so pleased to be part of this again for 2025. All the children will design and decorate the giraffe sculpture that will be part of the Break GoGo safari trail next summer in Norwich. It is expensive at £894 but the children always love being part of the event and enjoy doing the trail.

This term the children have already enjoyed a Halloween disco party as well as a fancy dress and colouring competition. We can look forward to running more fundraising events this year. Father Christmas will be visiting the children with sacks full of presents and the whole school are going to Yarmouth Hippodrome and will enjoy ice creams and coach travel with a contribution by the Friends of Corpusty Primary School. ☺
